I began visiting their home and building a friendship with Jose and Rosa. As they opened up to me, I shared God's love and forgiveness with them. Eventually, they both invited Jesus into their hearts, and I began to see a beautiful transformation taking place in their family.

A few months later, Jose told me, **"I am tired of doing drugs. I want to be free."**

We prayed and asked God to set him free. That night, Jose experienced God's freedom and stopped using drugs.



The family began coming to church, praying, and worshipping together. But there was still something that needed to happen.

One afternoon, I asked Jose and Rosa, "Have you forgiven each other?"

I watched God bring healing to a family that had been heading toward destruction and separation. Through His love, forgiveness, and grace, He was bringing this family back together.
